

Earning the HMDC® credential through the Hospice Medical Director Certification Board (HMDCB) shows your patients, families, colleagues, and employers your commitment to professional development and excellent clinical care.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS/PATHWAYS

As a candidate you must meet the following requirements:

- Hold a current, unrestricted license to practice medicine in the United States, U.S. territories, or in Canada
- · Conform to HMDCB's Code of Professional Conduct
- Demonstrate a minimum of 400 hours of broad hospice-related activities during the previous 5 years.

Once you have determined your eligibility, choose ONE of the following pathways:

- Practice Pathway: 2 years of work experience in a hospice setting during the previous 5 years
- Certification Pathway: Current, valid board certification in hospice and palliative medicine through the American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS) or the American Osteopathic Association (AOA)
- Training Pathway: Successful completion of a 12-month clinical hospice and palliative medicine training program accredited by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) or AOA.
