*Chicago, IL – December 2021* — The Hospice Medical Director Certification Board® (HMDCB®) has recently completed its third Continuing Certification Program (CCP) examination of hospice medical directors and hospice physicians. The 2021 CCP examination allowed for certificants that initially certified in 2015 and 2016 the opportunity to recertify. A total of 86 certificants successfully passed the CCP examination and will continue to hold the HMDC credential. The remaining 2016 certificants will have the opportunity to complete the CCP examination in 2022.
