



Initial Examination Code of Conduct

Certification by the Hospice Medical Director Certification Board® (HMDCB) carries an obligation for ethical behavior and professionalism in all conduct.

Ethical behavior and professionalism expected of all candidates includes:

- Submitting accurate, valid application information
- Respecting the confidentiality of examination questions and content
- Maintaining an unrestricted medical license in the United States, its territories, or Canada
- Accurately representing certification status at all times
- Maintaining ethical and professional behavior in all conduct

Hospice Medical Director Certification candidates will be required to sign a statement affirming adherence to the code when submitting their application.
